- Be available to travel to Brisbane, QLD on the 18th and 19th November 2020 for the Second Round of Judging; a face-to-face interview with the judging panel.
- Be available to attend ALFA's 50th
 Anniversary Event in Februrary 2021
 (date TBC) for for Final Round of Judging
 and the announcement of the Overall Winner.
